

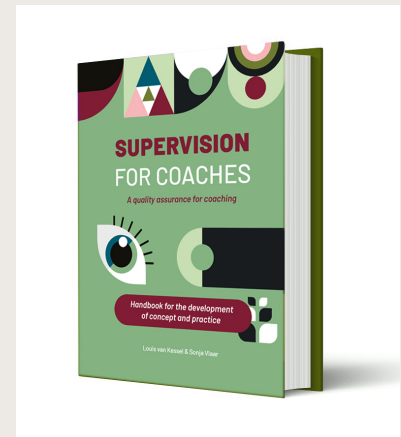
Supervision for Coaches
